Five-Day Implementation Model

Parish Summer Intensive

- Chapter 10 Pages 79–82. Emphasize that a parable is a story that teaches a lesson. Invite students in groups to write parables and perform them for the class. BLMs 36, 37
- Chapter 11 Pages 87-90. BLM 39
- Chapter 12 Pages 95–98. BLMs 41, 42A–B, 43A–B Invite students to assemble the Reconciliation Booklets found in the back of their books. BLMs 44A-B
- Chapter 13 Pages 103–107. Use the discussion cards on BLM 49 to have students in small groups discuss one of the topics on the cards. After some time, ask volunteers to summarize what their group discussed.
- Chapter 14 Pages 113–116. Emphasize the Beatitudes. BLMs 52A-B, 53, 54A-B Allow time for students to work individually on BLMs 55A-B. Invite students to share their calendars with the class at your next meeting.

- Chapter 15 In pairs, have students do the Centering activity (T135) then pages 121–124. Emphasize Catholic Social Teaching. Read aloud or invite a volunteer to read aloud each short article in BLMs 58A-C about those who have been witnesses of our Christian faith. Invite volunteers to answer the questions that follows each.
- Chapter 16 Pages 129–132. Use BLM 61 to lead a class discussion on decision making.
- Chapter 18 Pages 147–150. Emphasize the importance of responding to God's invitation to grow spiritually. BLMs 65A-F
- Chapter 19 Pages 155–158. Focus on Jesus' Death and Resurrection.
- Chapter 20 Pages 163–166. Distribute missalettes to students. Emphasize the Liturgy of the Eucharist and the Communion Rite (T181).

- Chapter 22 Pages 179–182. Emphasize the significance of the Resurrection and Ascension. BLMs 76, 77 On the board, write the statements from BLM 79. Have students write personal mission statements, using what you wrote on the board to prompt their thinking.
- Chapter 23 Pages 187–190. Emphasize the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and the birth of the Church. Have students work in teams to complete items 1–12 on BLM 81. **OPTION** Pentecost, pages 227–228
- Chapter 24 Pages 195–198. Emphasize the mission of bishops, priests, and deacons. Consider inviting your parish priest or deacon to speak to your class about his calling. BLM 84 Have students choose an activity from **BLM 85** to complete and share with the class.
- Celebration Hold the Our Journey in Life celebration, pages 206–207 (T228) or use BLMs 82A-D as a capstone activity. Hold the closing prayer service. **BLM 86**
