Page 111 Unit Opener

Say: *In Unit 4, you will learn more about the parts of the Mass.* Read aloud the unit title on page 111. Then read aloud the Scripture passage at the bottom of the page. Remind your child that the passage is from our holy book, the Bible.

Discuss the pictures on the page. Point out the pictures of Jesus and the boy with the loaves and fish, the Eucharist, and the Last Supper. Say: *All these pictures show Jesus giving the gift of himself to us. Jesus calls all of us to give ourselves to others in loving ways.*

If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and watch the video together.

Chapter 15: Jesus Promised the Gift of Himself

Page 113 Jesus Is the Bread of Life and Jesus Fed the People

Invite your child to read aloud page 113. Say: *Bread is a sign of life that stands for all food.* Ask: *Why does Jesus want us to come to him?* (Jesus loves us. He wants to help us follow him.) Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *miracle*.

Say: Jesus Christ gave us many gifts because he loves us so much. He thought of a way to give himself to us. We receive the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in Holy Communion.

If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and listen to the audio together.

Page 114 Jesus Promised to Give the Eucharist

Read aloud page 114. Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *Holy Communion*.

Say: We receive Jesus Christ's Body and Blood in Holy Communion. It really is Jesus. He shares his life and love with us. That is why Jesus said that whoever eats the living bread will live forever.

Page 115 The Body and Blood of Christ

Say: You are baptized and you belong to God's family, the Church. When you share Holy Communion, you are one with Jesus, God the Father, and the Holy Spirit. You are also one with all the people in the Church. Ask: How can you prepare your heart to receive Jesus in Holy Communion? (pray; take part in the Mass; obey the commandments; be kind)

Read aloud the directions and invite your child to complete the activity **The Body and Blood of Christ.** When he or she is finished, invite your child to share his or her work.

Lead your child in prayer using the **A Moment with Jesus** feature on page 115. Pray the Sign of the Cross to conclude the prayer.

Page 116 Chapter Review

Help your child complete the Chapter 15 Review on page 116. If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and have your child take the **Interactive Chapter Review**. Discuss the question under **We Remember**. Call your child's attention to the **We Respond** section and pray the prayer together. Review the **Words to Know** in this chapter by locating the words and their definitions in the **Glossary**. Allow time for your child to complete **The Eucharist** and **Your Turn** activities. Invite your child to share what he or she wrote.

Page 117 Families in Mission

Complete the Families in Mission pages with your child.

SCRIPTURE

Read aloud the text and the Scripture in the sidebar on page 117. Say: *When we come together in the Eucharist, we all share in the Body of Christ. We are one in Christ.*

KNOW AND PROCLAIM

Read aloud the **Know and Proclaim** text and the chart. Say: *When we receive Holy Communion, we receive Jesus Christ, the living bread. We are filled with his love.*

TEST YOUR CATHOLIC KNOWLEDGE

Read aloud the question and possible answers in **Test Your Catholic Knowledge.** Have your child answer the question. [ANSWER: receive the living bread.]

Read aloud the **Witness and Share** introductory text. Then read aloud each faith statement in **My Way to Faith**, pausing to allow time for your child to reflect on each one.

SHARE YOUR FAITH

Read aloud the directions in **Share Your Faith** and have your child complete the activity. Say: *Jesus wants us to live in his grace as members of his Body. We can be helpful, kind, and loving. We can do our best to make the world a beautiful place.*

Page 119 God's People Celebrate Passover

Read aloud page 119. Say: *Because Jesus, Mary, and Joseph were Jewish, they also celebrated Passover.* Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *Passover.* Invite your child to complete the activity **The Story of the First Passover**. When he or she is finished, go over the answers. Then pray together the Scripture passage from the **God's Word** feature. Conclude with the Sign of the Cross.

Page 120 Jesus Celebrates a Sacred Meal

Ask your child to read aloud the first paragraph on page 120. Say: *When Jesus washed his Apostles' feet, he was doing the job of a servant.* Ask: *How do you think the Apostles felt when Jesus washed their feet? How would you have felt?* Read aloud the first Scripture passage on page 120. Ask: *What do you think Jesus wanted his Apostles to do?* (be thoughtful and helpful) Read aloud the rest of the page. Ask: *What was the new commandment that Jesus gave us?* (Love one another.)

Page 121 Jesus Gave the Gift of Himself at the Last Supper

Read aloud page 121. Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *Last Supper*. Say: *Jesus showed his great love for his Father and for us when he offered himself as a sacrifice. He would offer himself again on the Cross the next day.* Say: *At Mass, Jesus comes to us in Holy Communion.*

If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and listen to the audio together.

Page 122 Jesus Gives Himself for Us

Take turns with your child reading aloud page 122. Discuss Jesus' gift of love. Say: Jesus gave his life on the Cross to make up for our sins. Through Jesus' sacrifice, we can be together with God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit in heaven someday. Jesus is in heaven, and he is here with us too. Jesus gave us the Mass so that we can offer his perfect gift to God our Father. Lead your child in prayer using the A Moment with Jesus feature on page 122. Then together pray the Sign of the Cross.

Page 123 We Give Ourselves

Invite your child to read aloud page 123 and have your child complete the activity **What Happens at Mass.** Then introduce the Morning Prayer. Say: *One way we can give the gift of ourselves to God is by praying the Morning Prayer. We can offer all our thoughts, actions, and kind words as gifts to God.* Pray together the Morning Prayer on the inside front cover of the Student Book. Then together pray the Sign of the Cross.

Page 124 Chapter Review

Help your child complete the Chapter 16 Review on page 50. If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and have your child take the **Interactive Chapter Review**. Discuss the question under **We Remember**. Call your child's attention to the **We Respond** section and pray the prayer together. Review the **Words to Know** in this chapter by locating each word and its definition in the **Glossary**. Allow time for your child to complete the **Your Turn** activity. Ask your child to share what he or she drew.

Page 125 Families in Mission

Complete the Families in Mission pages with your child.

SCRIPTURE

Read aloud the text and the Scripture in the sidebar on page 125. Say: *A sacrifice is a gift of love we do for others. Jesus gave himself to the Father as a sacrifice on the Cross. Jesus' sacrifice for our sins was the greatest gift of love.*

Read aloud the **Know and Proclaim** text and the chart. Say: **At the Last Supper, Jesus told his Apostles how important this meal was to him. He knew he would give up his life on the Cross the next day. Jesus offered himself to his Father by doing what the Father wanted him to do.**

TEST YOUR CATHOLIC KNOWLEDGE

Read aloud the question and possible answers in **Test Your Catholic Knowledge.** Have your child answer the question. [ANSWER: Jesus' gift of himself.]

Page 127 We Come with Love and Joy

(We can share in God's life and live with him forever in heaven.) Say: By participating in the Mass, we celebrate Jesus' great love.

Page 128 We Gather Together

Take turns with your child reading aloud page 128. Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *altar*. Explain the Entrance and the Greeting. Say: *There is a procession at the beginning of Mass. It reminds us that everyone has come into God's house to praise and thank God. In the Greeting, the priest gives us God's blessing.* Read aloud the directions for **The Table of the Lord** and invite your child to complete the activity.

Page 129 We Ask for Mercy

Read aloud page 129. Say: At the beginning of Mass, we are asked to think about how we have loved God and others. We also think about how we have sometimes been unloving. We ask God for forgiveness. When our sins are forgiven, we are one with God and with one another. We are God's loving family. Lead your child in prayer using the A Moment with Jesus feature. Then pray together the Sign of the Cross.

Page 130 We Praise God and We Ask and God Hears

Invite your child to read aloud **We Praise God** on page 130. Say: *We praise God for giving Jesus to us and for all his blessings. We use the words the angels sang the night Jesus was born.* Then explain the Collect or opening prayer. Say: *During this time, we pray quietly for the needs of God's family. Then the priest gathers all our prayers into one prayer to God.* Then read aloud **We Ask and God Hears.** Ask: **What does** *Amen* **mean?** (It means "Yes, we agree.") Ask your child to complete and share his or her prayer from the activity **We Are Blessed**.

Read aloud page 131 and ask your child to complete the activities **What We Do at Mass** and **Mass Is a Celebration**. When he or she is finished, go over the correct answers and invite your child to share his or her work.

If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and watch the video together.

Page 135 We Listen to the Word of the Lord

Read aloud page 135. Say: *The First Reading is from the Old Testament of the Bible. Then we pray a psalm that praises and thanks God. On Sundays and feast days, a lector reads a Second Reading from the New Testament of the Bible. After each reading, we say, "Thanks be to God."* Invite your child to say this response aloud with you. Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *Liturgy of the Word*. Remind your child that we hear God speak to us in the Bible.

Page 136 We Listen to the Gospel

Read aloud the first paragraph on page 136. Say: *Jesus' friends wanted all people to know about him, so they wrote his life story, which we call the Gospels. The word* gospel *means "good news." We sing, "Alleluia," a word of joy to show we are happy to hear the Good News of Jesus.* Invite your child to read aloud the rest of the page. Call your child's attention to the **Word to Know** feature. Read aloud the definition for *ambo*. Invite your child to complete the activity **The Evangelists.** Then go over the answers.

Page 137 We Tell God We Believe

Read aloud page 137. Say: At Sunday Mass, we pray the Nicene Creed. We do our best to live as God wants us to live. We believe in God's power and love for us. We pray to God when we need help.

If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and experience the media together.

Page 138 We Ask God for Help

Read aloud page 138. Say: *Sometimes God answers our prayers by giving us something we didn't expect. Sometimes God has a different plan than we do. It is important to trust God and his plan, even if we don't always understand it.* Discuss the needs of the people pictured on page 138 and how you can pray for them. Read aloud the directions for Lord, Hear My Prayer and invite your child to complete the activity.

Lead your child in prayer using the **A Moment with Jesus** feature. Then pray the Sign of the Cross. Invite your child to spend some quiet time with Jesus each day.

Have your child read aloud Jesus Offers Himself with Love on page 150. Say: At this time during the Mass, Jesus offers himself to God our Father like he did at the Last Supper and on the Cross. We can pray with Jesus as we offer his sacrifice and ourselves to God our Father.

Then read aloud We Offer Ourselves with Jesus on page 150. Say: We can offer God our happy and sad times, the times that we are sharing, caring, and loving, and the times we are helpful and kind. Guide your child in prayer using the A Moment with Jesus feature. Invite your child to talk and listen to Jesus in the quiet of his or her heart. Then together pray the Sign of the Cross.

Page 151 We Remember What Jesus Christ Has Done

Have your child read aloud page 151. Then read aloud the directions for We Proclaim Our Faith and Jesus Gives Himself to the Father. Ask your child to complete the activities. When he or she has finished, go over the answers.

Page 152 Chapter Review

Page 155 We Prepare to Receive Jesus

Say: During the Mass, we prepare ourselves in many ways to receive Jesus, the Bread of Life, in Holy Communion.

Take turns with your child reading aloud page 155. Say: *In the Lord's Prayer, we ask God to "give us our daily bread." This means the food that keeps us strong and healthy, the Bread of Life that helps us live as God's children. Also in the Lord's Prayer, we tell God our Father that we are willing to forgive one another so that we can be one family in love.*

Pray the Lamb of God prayer with your child.

Page 156 We Remember Jesus' Love

Read aloud page 156. Say: The word unworthy means to feel not good enough, or to feel undeserving. In the prayer we pray before Holy Communion, we say we feel unworthy to have Jesus come to us because he is the Son of God. We cannot love Jesus more than he loves us. We tell Jesus we believe that when he comes to us, he will give us his life and his love.

Invite your child to read the directions and complete the activity **We Ask Jesus to Heal Us.** Then go over the answers together.

If you choose, scan the QR code on the page and interact with the media together.

Page 157 Jesus Comes to Us in Holy Communion

Read aloud page 157. Remind your child that the word *Amen* means "Yes, I believe I am receiving Jesus."

Practice receiving the Eucharist with your child until he or she is comfortable with the process. Say: *Pray often to Jesus and tell him how happy you are to receive him in Holy Communion.*

Page 158 We Receive Jesus

Invite your child to read aloud page 158. Then lead him or her in prayer using the **A Moment with Jesus** feature.
