Ten-Day Implementation Model Parish Summer Intensive

The ten-day summer intensive program takes place over ten three-and-a-half-hour days. Approximately 50 minutes is devoted to each session with an additional five minutes to introduce and discuss the unit saint. Sessions may be extended to fill the time available by using all the BLMs and optional activities, especially activities such as field trips and projects that require additional time.

DAY 1 UNIT 1: GOD, OUR CREATOR AND FATHER SESSIONS 1-4

Before the Day Begins

- Read page EC-8 behind the Effective Catechist tab in the Catechist Guide.
- Read the Catechist Preparation material that precedes Sessions 1–4 (pages 1a–d, 9a–b, 15a–b, 21a–b).

Begin by Praying Together

Establish the pattern and tone for prayer. Pray the opening prayer on page 3. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

Steps

- Unit Saint Page 1. Introduce the Unit 1 saint.
- Sessions 1–4 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach each session following the Engage, Explore, and Reflect steps. Skip the Respond step for each session or assign the Living My Faith pages for homework. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Art Print BLMs 1, 2, 3, 4

Conclude by Praying Together

Pray the closing prayer on page 26. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

DAY 2 UNIT 1: GOD OUR CREATOR AND FATHER CELEBRATING SESSION 5

Before the Day Begins

Read the Catechist Preparation material on pages 27a-b.

Definitions for terms shown in boldface type can be found in the Glossary at the back of the Children's Books. When a boldface term is encountered in the text, invite a volunteer to look up its meaning in the Glossary.

Begin by Praying Together

Pray the opening prayer on page 27. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

Steps

- Session 5 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach Session 5 following the Engage, Explore, Reflect, and Respond steps. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Session 5 BLM; Art Print BLM 5
- **The Year in Our Church** Pages 151–152. Based on the time you have with the children, decide which elements of the Seasonal Session can be easily incorporated into instruction of the Celebrating Session. You might have children complete the **Liturgical Calendar BLM** after reading the Explore step in Celebrating Session 5 or at the end of the day. Have students make Feasts and Seasons Booklets (If Time Allows activity, page 151).

Begin by Praying Together

Pray the opening prayer on page 33. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

Steps

- Unit Saint Page 31. Introduce the Unit 2 saint.
- Sessions 6–9 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach each session following the Engage, Explore, and Reflect steps. Skip the Respond step for each session or assign the Living My Faith pages for homework. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Art Print BLMs 6, 7, 8, 9

Begin by Praying Together

Pray the opening prayer on page 57. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

Steps

- Session 10 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach Session 10 following the Engage, Explore, Reflect, and Respond steps. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Session 10 BLM; Art Print BLM 10
- Advent Pages 153–156. Based on the time you have with the children, decide which elements of the Seasonal Session can be easily incorporated into instruction of the Celebrating Session. You might have children complete the Advent BLM after reading the Explore step in Celebrating Session 10 or after the prayer service. End the day with the Advent Prayer Service on page 156.

Begin by Praying Together

Pray the opening prayer on page 63. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

- Unit Saint Page 61. Introduce the Unit 3 saint.
- Sessions 11–14 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach each session following the Engage, Explore, and Reflect steps. Skip the Respond step for each session or assign the Living My Faith pages for homework. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Art Print BLMs 11, 12, 13, 14

Session 15 BLM; Art Print BLM 15
- **Christmas** Pages 157–160. Based on the time you have with the children, decide which elements of the Seasonal Session can be easily incorporated into instruction of the Celebrating Session. You might have children complete the **Christmas BLM** after reading the Explore step in Celebrating Session 15 or after the prayer service. End the day with the Christmas Prayer Service on page 160.

Pray the opening prayer on page 93. Emphasize the gestures as you pray the Sign of the Cross before and after the prayer.

- Sessions 16–19 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach each session following the Engage, Explore, and Reflect steps. Skip the Respond step for each session or assign the Living My Faith pages for homework. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Art Print BLMs 16, 17, 18, 19

Session 20 BLM; Art Print BLM 20
- Lent and Holy Week Pages 161–168. Based on the time you have with the children, decide which elements of both Seasonal Sessions can be easily incorporated into instruction of the Celebrating Session. You might have children complete the Lent BLM and Holy Week BLM after reading the Explore step in Celebrating Session 20 or after the prayer service. End the day with the Holy Week Prayer Service on page 168.

- Sessions 21–24 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach each session following the Engage, Explore, and Reflect steps. Skip the Respond step for each session or assign the Living My Faith pages for homework. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Art Print BLMs 21, 22, 23, 24

- Session 25 Use the corresponding pages in the Catechist Guide and program components to teach Session 25 following the Engage, Explore, Reflect, and Respond steps. Refer to the background and support material provided behind the Art Print Catechist Pages tab of the Catechist Guide or on the back of the Art Print in conjunction with the corresponding Art Print BLM. Session 25 BLM; Art Print BLM 20
- **Easter** (Grades 1–5), **Easter and Ascension** (Grade 6) Pages 169–172. Based on the time you have with the children, decide which elements of the Seasonal Session can be easily incorporated into instruction of the Celebrating Session. You might have children complete the **Easter BLM** after reading the Explore step in Celebrating Session 25 or after the prayer service. End the day with the Easter Prayer Service on page 172.
