Scripture Together

Jesus often told stories to teach people lessons. Jesus told the story of the Good Samaritan when someone asked him, “Who is my neighbor?” In the story, Jesus teaches what one person did when he saw someone in need.

As a family, read Jesus’ story about the Good Samaritan in **Luke 10:29–37**.

When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. You may use the following questions to prompt discussion:

- Why does the Samaritan stop to help the traveler?
- What does the story teach about who your neighbor is?
- How does Jesus want you to treat people you meet even if you do not know them?
