

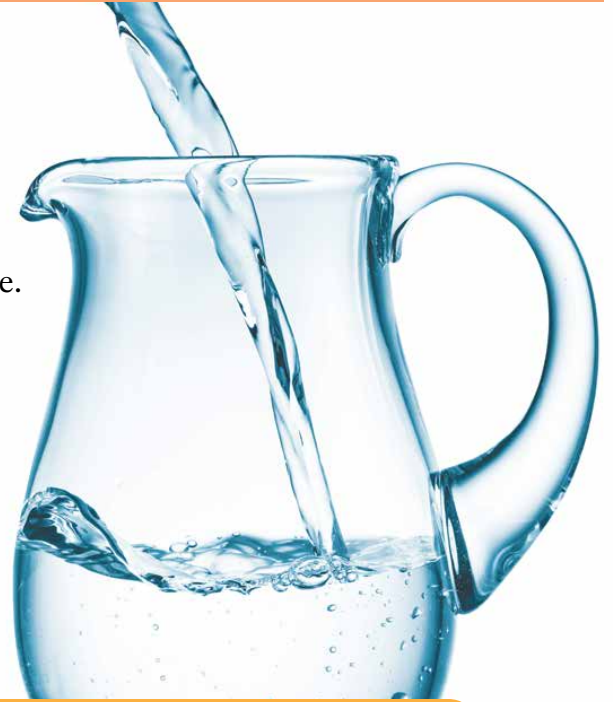
With My Family

Scripture Together

Before he died, Jesus taught his friends how to treat one another. Jesus told them no one is greater than anyone else. God blesses us as we serve others.

As a family, read about the washing of the feet in **John 13:12–17**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. You may use the following questions to prompt discussion:

- Why did Jesus wash his friends' feet?
- What do you think Jesus is telling us about how we are to relate to one another?
- How can you “wash” the feet of your family members this week?

Dear God, thank you for teaching us how to live and pray. Amen.

Ask one another: *What part of the Lord's Prayer means the most to you?*

ACTIVITY: Family Foot Washing

Have a family foot washing in which family members take turns washing one another's feet. Discuss how no one in the family is more important than the others. Talk about how Jesus calls us to treat one another with love and respect and to serve one another. Discuss how it is equally important to receive love and be grateful when others serve us.
