After the Resurrection, Jesus appeared to two of his friends on a road. They were sad because Jesus had died. At first they did not know Jesus. They recognized Jesus that evening when he blessed bread, broke it, and gave it to them.

As a family, read about Jesus meeting his disciples in **Luke 24:13–35**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. You may use the following questions to prompt discussion:

- What does Jesus explain as he walks with his friends?
- What things do you think about as Jesus walks with you?
- How do you help our family walk with Jesus?
