

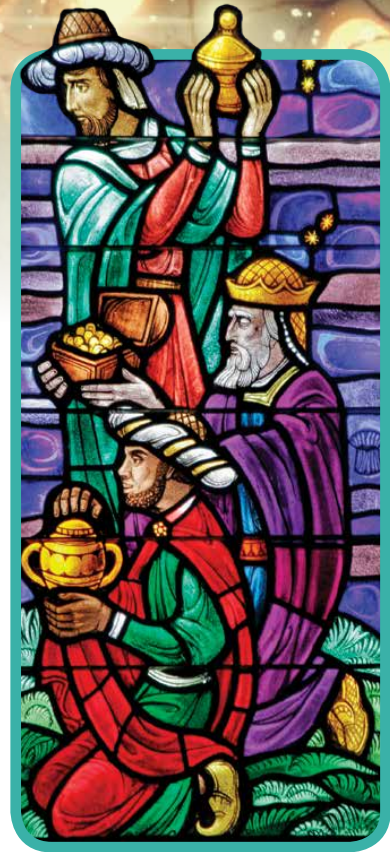
With My Family

📖 Scripture Together

The Magi were Wise Men who traveled a long distance to behold and worship the infant Messiah. They were led by great faith as they made the journey. Though the Magi had not yet seen the child Jesus, they believed in their hearts that he was the promised Savior.

As a family, read **Matthew 2:1–12**. Then discuss the Scripture passage using the following questions to guide you:

- What do you know about the Magi from the passage?
- If you were with the Magi, what gifts would you want to bring Jesus?
- What does the example of the Magi teach you about faith?
