
Scripture Together

The Apostle Paul spent time in the ancient Greek city of Corinth to encourage the Christians there to live holy lives. He taught the Corinthians about the meaning of the Last Supper and how we must receive the Body and Blood of Christ with pure hearts and reverence for God.

As a family, read **1 Corinthians 11:23–26**.

Then discuss the Scripture passage using the following questions to guide you:

- What does Jesus say after sharing his Body and Blood?
- What does Paul say you are doing every time you celebrate the Eucharist? What do you think he means?
- How can you prepare your heart to receive Jesus in the Eucharist?
