Scripture Together

The apostle Paul wrote the Letter to the Romans to encourage believers in ancient Rome. He reminds them that their sins are forgiven and that they are saved by grace through Christ Jesus. Later in the letter, he instructs them on how to pursue Christian virtues.

As a family, read **Romans 12:9–18**. Then discuss the Scripture passage using the following questions to guide you:

- How does Paul tell us we should love others?
- What advice in the passage strikes you the most? Why?
- What can this Scripture passage teach you about how to live your faith?
