- What are you as a Christian called to do today?

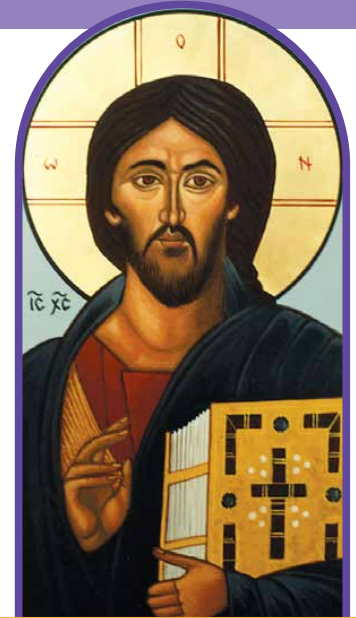
Faith on the Go
