White is the liturgical color of Christmas. In Scripture, white is often used to show holiness. It is a symbol of purity, transformation, and the brightness of God's love. Sometimes, the symbolic color appears in a quite literal and dazzling way.

As a family, read **Mark 9:2–3**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. Consider the following questions to help guide discussion:

- How are Jesus' clothes described?
- How would you have reacted to the sight of someone being transfigured like this?
- What can you do to share God's brightness with others?
