## 📖 Scripture Together

Christians who live in community with one another are called to do more than just coexist. True unity requires work from everyone. In his letter to the Ephesians, Saint Paul provides detailed instructions on how people can live together in peace.

As a family, read **Ephesians 4:25–32**. When you have finished reading, discuss the Scripture. Use the following questions to prompt discussion:

- What does Saint Paul say we must do and must avoid doing?
- Which good behaviors that Saint Paul mentions seem easier or harder to you?
- How can you put these rules to work here in our home?
