If we take the time to walk a mile in another person’s shoes, we can better understand his or her suffering and offer the kind of help he or she needs. While preaching to a crowd, Saint Paul paid close attention to one man in particular and soon demonstrated how God inspires his followers to minister to others.

As a family, read **Acts of the Apostles 14:8–10**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. Consider the following questions to help guide discussion:

- How did Paul interact with the man before healing him?
- How do you think Paul recognized that the man had faith?
- How can you help someone who you know is suffering?
