As a family, read **Romans 12:12–17**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. Consider the following questions to help guide discussion:

- What is one thing Paul encourages us to do?
- Which piece of advice do you find most challenging or confusing? Why?
- Which behavior listed in this Scripture would you especially like to try here in our home?
