

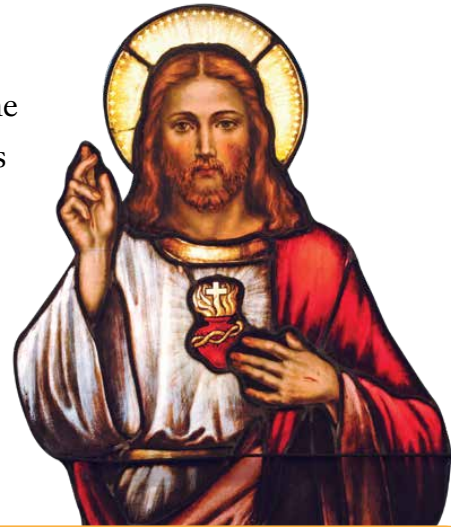
With My Family

As a family, read about Jesus as the head of the Church in **Colossians 1:17–18**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. Use the following questions to prompt discussion:

- What does it mean that in Jesus “all things hold together”?
- Jesus is the head of the Body. How are we his hands and feet in the world?
- How do you and your family show that Jesus is the head of the Church?
