📖 Scripture Together

The Gospel writers recognized the hope expressed in the writings of the prophets. We can also find hope in these writings and in other Scripture passages. Paul referred to the prophets when instructing the early Christians to welcome all people and help them glorify God.

As a family, read about how Saint Paul encouraged the early Christians to be hopeful in **Romans 15:7-13**. When you have finished, discuss the Scripture. Use the following questions to help guide discussion:

- To whom is Paul referring when he writes about the Gentiles?
- Why is unity important in the Church?
- How can you and your family show that you are united with your faith community?
