- What are some difficult events in our own lives that we later realized were a blessing?

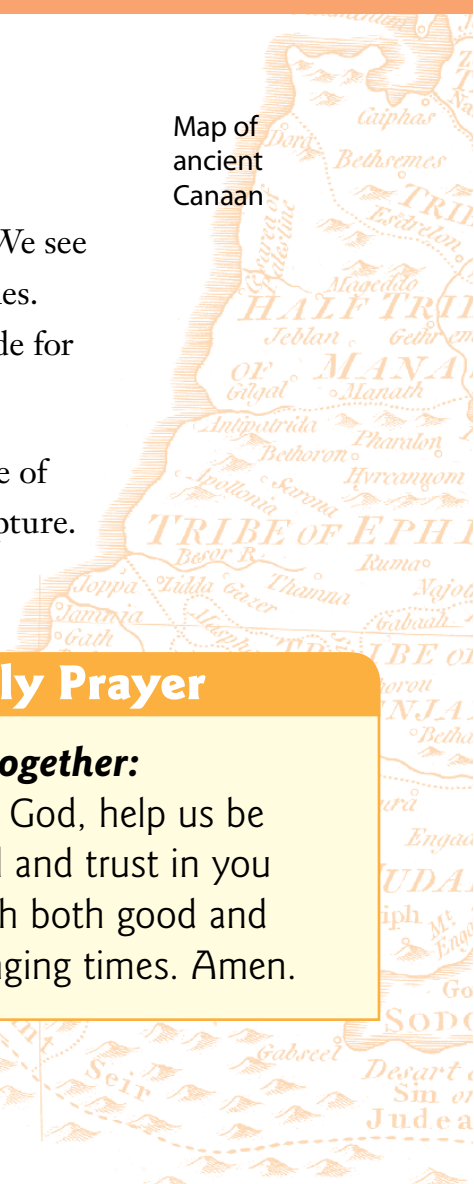
Faith on the Go
